- 2 77-2704.10, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to exempt
- 3 food sold by veterans service organizations from sales and use tax
- 4 as prescribed; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the
- 5 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 3 77-2704.10 Sales and use taxes shall not be imposed on the gross
- 4 receipts from the sale, lease, or rental of and the storage, use, or
- 5 other consumption in this state of:
- 6 (1) Prepared food and food ingredients served by public or
- 7 private schools, school districts, student organizations, or parent-
- 8 teacher associations pursuant to an agreement with the proper school
- 9 authorities, in an elementary or secondary school or at any institution
- 10 of higher education, public or private, during the regular school day or
- 11 at an approved function of any such school or institution. This exemption
- 12 does not apply to sales by an institution of higher education at any
- 13 facility or function which is open to the general public;
- 14 (2) Prepared food and food ingredients sold by a church at
- 15 a function of such church;
- 16 (3) Prepared food and food ingredients served to patients
- 17 and inmates of hospitals and other institutions licensed by the state for
- 18 the care of human beings;
- 19 (4) Prepared food and food ingredients sold at a political
- 20 event by ballot question committees, candidate committees, independent
- 21 committees, and political party committees as defined in the Nebraska
- 22 Political Accountability and Disclosure Act or fees and admissions
- 23 charged for such political event;
- 24 (5) Prepared food and food ingredients sold to the elderly,
- 25 handicapped, or recipients of Supplemental Security Income by an
- 26 organization that actually accepts electronic benefits transfer under
- 27 regulations issued by the United States Department of Agriculture
- 28 although it is not necessary for the purchaser to use electronic benefits
- 29 transfer to pay for the prepared food and food and food ingredients;
- 30 (6) Prepared food and food ingredients sold by a veterans
- 31 service organization that is congressionally chartered, has active

- 1 chapters in Nebraska, and is exempt from federal income tax under section
- 2 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended;
- 3 $(\underline{7} \ 6)$ Fees and admissions charged by a public or private elementary
- 4 or secondary school and fees and admissions charged by a school district,
- 5 student organization, or parent-teacher association, pursuant to an
- 6 agreement with the proper school authorities, in a public or private
- 7 elementary or secondary school during the regular school day or at an
- 8 approved function of any such school;
- 9 (8 7) Fees and admissions charged for participants in any activity
- 10 provided by a nonprofit organization that is exempt from income tax under
- 11 section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, which
- 12 organization conducts statewide sport events with multiple sports for
- 13 both adults and youth; and
- 14 (9 8) Fees and admissions charged for participants in any activity
- 15 provided by a nonprofit organization that is exempt from income tax under
- 16 section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, which
- 17 organization is affiliated with a national organization, primarily
- 18 dedicated to youth development and healthy living, and offers sports
- 19 instruction and sports leagues or sports events in multiple sports.
