- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the state building division; to amend
- 2 section 81-1108.33, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 provisions relating to acquisitions of real property; and to repeal
- 4 the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 81-1108.33, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

2 is amended to read:

3 81-1108.33 (1) It is the intent of the Legislature that the state 4 will not assume responsibility for the substandard construction, repair, or maintenance of, or for the excessive maintenance or repair costs for, 5 real property, structures, or improvements which will be made available 6 7 by gift, bequest, or devise to any state agency, board, or commission or real property or structures acquired by any state agency, board, or 8 9 commission with the proceeds of donations, gifts, bequests, devises, or grants from individuals, organizations, corporations, foundations, or 10 similar entities or from nonfederal governmental agencies. Therefor, any 11 such gift, bequest, devise, or acquisition of such real property, 12 13 structure, or improvement shall be reviewed and approved as provided in 14 this section as a requirement for acceptance or acquisition by the state of such real property, structure, or improvement. 15

16 (2)(a) Any gift of, bequest of, or devise of real property, a 17 structure, or an improvement proposed to be made available to any state agency, board, or commission in excess of ten thousand dollars and any 18 acquisition of real property or structures with the proceeds of 19 bequests, devises, or grants from individuals, 20 donations, gifts, organizations, corporations, foundations, or similar entities or from 21 nonfederal governmental agencies, if the combined proceeds of such 22 23 donations, gifts, bequests, devises, or grants exceed two hundred fifty 24 thousand dollars, shall be reviewed by the state building division and 25 the Task Force for Building Renewal pursuant to sections 81-176, 81-1108.15, and 81-1114. Such review shall include any potential matching 26 of state funds, any plans, specifications, and other construction or 27 28 repair documents, and any potential maintenance requirements as a condition of acceptance or acquisition. Subsequent to such review, the 29 state building division and the task force shall submit a report to the 30 Governor, the Committee on Building Maintenance, and the Legislative 31

- 1 Fiscal Analyst including a summary of the review of the plans,
- 2 specifications, and other construction or repair documents and potential
- 3 maintenance requirements and outlining the terms and conditions of the
- 4 proposed gift, bequest, devise, or acquisition along with its
- 5 recommendation. The report submitted to the committee and the Legislative
- 6 Fiscal Analyst shall be submitted electronically.
- 7 (b)(i) Any proposed gift of, bequest of, or devise of real property,
- 8 a structure, or an improvement in excess of ten thousand dollars shall be
- 9 approved by the Governor and the Legislature prior to acceptance.
- 10 (ii) Any acquisition of real property or structures with the
- 11 proceeds of donations, gifts, bequests, devises, or grants from
- 12 individuals, organizations, corporations, foundations, or similar
- 13 entities or from nonfederal governmental agencies, if the combined
- 14 proceeds of such donations, gifts, bequests, devises, or grants exceed
- 15 two hundred fifty thousand dollars and if the combined proceeds exceed
- 16 the existing capital appropriation for the acquisition, shall be approved
- 17 by the Governor and Legislature prior to such acquisition.
- 18 (iii) If the Legislature is not in session, the Executive Board of
- 19 the Legislative Council, after recommendation by the Committee on
- 20 Building Maintenance, may approve such gift, bequest, devise, or
- 21 acquisition along with the Governor.
- 22 (c) No construction, repair, maintenance, or other work related to
- 23 the proposed gift, bequest, devise, or acquisition shall be initiated
- 24 prior to receiving the review and approval required by this section.
- 25 (3) For purposes of this section, gift of, bequest of, or devise of
- 26 (a) real property, (b) a structure, or (c) an improvement shall include,
- 27 but not be limited to, a donation of, gift of, bequest of, devise of, or
- 28 grant of (i) real property, (ii) a structure, or (iii) an improvement
- 29 from an individual, an organization, a corporation, a foundation, or a
- 30 similar entity or from a nonfederal governmental agency. For purposes of
- 31 this section, gift, bequest, or devise shall not include a donation,

- 1 gift, bequest, devise, or grant of tangible or intangible personal
- 2 property.
- 3 (4) This section shall not apply to the University of Nebraska or
- 4 any Nebraska state college, since these agencies are subject to and
- 5 participate in statewide facilities planning developed by the
- 6 Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education pursuant to the
- 7 Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education Act.
- 8 Sec. 2. Original section 81-1108.33, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 9 Nebraska, is repealed.
