   68-1006.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to change
   the personal needs allowance under the Medical Assistance Act; and
   to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 68-1006.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2014, is amended to read:

68-1006.01 The Department of Health and Human Services shall include
in the standard of need for eligible aged, blind, and disabled persons at
least fifty seventy-five dollars per month for a personal needs allowance
if such persons reside in an alternative living arrangement.

7 For purposes of this section, an alternative living arrangement 8 shall include board and room, a boarding home, a certified adult family 9 home, a licensed assisted-living facility, a licensed residential child-10 caring agency as defined in section 71-1926, a licensed center for the 11 developmentally disabled, and a long-term care facility.

Sec. 2. Original section 68-1006.01, Revised Statutes CumulativeSupplement, 2014, is repealed.
