A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Exchange Transparency Act; to
 amend section 44-8704, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014;
 to change provisions relating to meetings of a commission; to repeal
 the original section; and to declare an emergency.
 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 44-8704, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2014, is amended to read:

3 44-8704 (1) The Nebraska Exchange Stakeholder Commission shall 4 organize by selecting a chairperson and a vice-chairperson who shall hold 5 office at the pleasure of the commission. The vice-chairperson shall act 6 as chairperson in the absence of the chairperson or in the event of a 7 vacancy in that position.

8 (2) The commission shall hold at least <u>three</u> four meetings annually,
9 at times and places fixed by the chairperson.

10 (3) A majority of the members of the commission shall constitute a11 quorum.

(4) Members of the commission shall be reimbursed for their actual
and necessary expenses as provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.

14 Sec. 2. Original section 44-8704, Revised Statutes Cumulative 15 Supplement, 2014, is repealed.

16 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when 17 passed and approved according to law.

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
