- 2 amended to read:
- 3 37-419 (1) Any person in the military service of the United States,
- 4 regardless of residence, who has been ordered to active duty at any
- 5 facility of the <u>United States</u> Department of Defense or its component
- 6 services located in the State of Nebraska, may hunt, fish, or harvest fur
- 7 on the appropriate resident permit upon satisfactory proof that such
- 8 person has been actually present for duty at such facility for a period
- 9 of thirty days or more.
- 10 (2) The spouse of any person in the military service of the United
- 11 States, regardless of residence, who has been ordered to active duty at
- 12 <u>any facility of the United States Department of Defense or its component</u>
- 13 <u>services located in the State of Nebraska, may hunt, fish, or harvest fur</u>
- 14 on the appropriate resident permit upon satisfactory proof that his or
- 15 her spouse has been actually present for duty at such facility for a
- 16 period of thirty days or more.
- 17 (3 2) Any person enrolled and in actual attendance as a full-time
- 18 student in any university, college, junior college, or vocational-
- 19 technical college in this state, regardless of residence, or any high
- 20 school foreign exchange student in this state, may hunt or fish on the
- 21 appropriate resident permit upon satisfactory proof that such person has
- 22 been actually in attendance at any such institution for a period of
- 23 thirty days or more or is a high school foreign exchange student.
