- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 82-326, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 82-326 The amount of money made available from any appropriations under the provisions of sections 82-317 to 82-329, 85-106 to 85-106.03, 4 and 85-304 to 85-304.03 shall be used, in addition to the cost of the 5 works of art, to provide for the administration by the contracting 6 agency, the architect, and the Nebraska Arts Council, and for all costs 7 of installation of the works of art as negotiated between the contracting 8 9 agency and the contracted artist. The Nebraska Arts Council may designate <u>a portion</u> set aside up to ten percent of the amount appropriated for 10 administration for an art maintenance fund which shall be used to repair 11 or restore all works of art acquired under such sections. 12
