- 1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA,
- 2 SECOND SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2016 the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To add a new section 26 to Article XV:
- 7 XV-26 (1) To protect agriculture as a vital sector of Nebraska's
- 8 economy, which provides food, energy, health benefits, and security and
- 9 <u>is the foundation and stabilizing force of Nebraska's economy, the rights</u>
- 10 of citizens and lawful residents of Nebraska to engage in farming and
- 11 ranching practices shall be forever guaranteed in this state, and the
- 12 Legislature shall pass no law which abridges the right of citizens and
- 13 lawful residents of Nebraska to employ agricultural technology and
- 14 livestock production and ranching practices without a compelling state
- 15 interest.
- 16 (2) This section shall not be construed to modify any provision of
- 17 law relating to trespass, eminent domain, dominance of mineral interests,
- 18 <u>easements</u>, <u>rights of way</u>, <u>or any other property rights</u>.
- 19 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 20 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 21 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 22 A constitutional amendment to guarantee the right to engage in
- 23 certain farming and ranching practices.
