Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1077 would allow a court, when imposing sentence for a person convicted of driving under a court order revoking his or her operator's license, the discretion to not revoke a person's operator's license if the court places the person on probation. If the court does not place a person on probation, then the court would revoke the person's operator's license for an additional one year period of time for a first offense and an additional two years for a subsequent offense.
