The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 147 is intended to streamline the administration of several public assistance programs under the purview of ACCESSNebraska.

The bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to eliminate the asset test for eligibility for the Aid to Dependent Children (ADC) program and federal food assistance benefits pursuant to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). Income requirements and work requirements for all able-bodied individuals still apply.
