The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 213 would create the definition of autocycle. An autocycle is defined as a motor vehicle having a seat for the use of the operator, designed to travel on three wheels in contact with the ground, in which the operator and passenger ride in a tandem seating area that is completely enclosed with a removable or fixed top and is equipped with air bag protection, a roll cage, and a three-point safety belt system for each occupant, having antilock brakes, and designed to be controlled with a steering wheel and pedals.

Autocycles and operators of autocycles would be subject to the Motor Vehicle Certificate Act, the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act and the Nebraska Rules and the Road.
