Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB340 provides for a definition of the term 'posted conspicuous notice' in the Concealed Handgun Permit Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. 69-2427 to 69-2449). Currently, 'posted conspicuous notice' is not explicitly defined. LB340 would define 'posted conspicuous notice' to mean "a clearly visible sign posted at the entrance to a place or premises open to the public." In addition, the 'visible sign posted' must be of certain content, minimum size, and placed in a certain location and shall be designed by the Nebraska State Patrol.
