The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB353 amends the Nursing Home Administrator Practice Act to require a baccalaureate degree instead of an associates degree for individuals seeking licensure after October 2017. An advanced degree helps an administrator with the demanding and complex realities of running a nursing home. The delayed implementation is intended to keep the existing requirements for anyone currently in an associates degree program, and grandfather in those with existing licenses.
