The department may grant earned time if the department finds the committed offender is actively engaged in a vocational, educational, industrial, work, or treatment program. If the committed offender commits an offense or violates a rule of the department during the term of imprisonment, the department may forfeit or suspend all or any of the committed offender's accrued earned time.
