The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Would allow residents of the state to submit any federal firearm form requiring law enforcement certification by a chief law enforcement officer to the chief law enforcement officer in the county in which they reside or to the chief law enforcement officer of an adjacent county of their residence.

Additionally, it states that the chief law enforcement officer shall accept and process the federal firearm form as long as the individual meets the qualifications.

Specifies that the chief law enforcement officer shall charge no more than the five-dollar fee, currently allowed for the criminal history record check, regardless of how many forms are submitted at the same time.
