## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

## LB788

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB788 would update the Professional Landscape Architects Act. The Bill makes the following substantive changes:

- 1. Revises the definitions of Landscape Architecture and Professional Landscape Architect.
- 2. Adds definitions for Coordinating Professional, Design Professional, Landscape Architect Intern, and License.
- 3. Gives authority to the Board to recover costs associated with online renewals and applications.
- 4. Gives authority to the Board to cover costs to promote licensure.
- 5. Changes from an annual to biennial license renewal.
- 6. Revises licensure requirements to allow for licensure by experience and applicants without a Council of Architect Registration Board (CLARB) certified council record.
- 7. Expands on the actions the Board may take on compliance cases.
- 8. Adds the procedure the Board is to following on compliance cases.
- 9. Gives the Board authority to access a penalty and the ability to recover costs on compliance cases.
- 10. Revises the exemptions for when a professional landscape architect is not required.
- 11. Expands on when a seal is required.
- 12. Removes the military renewal exemption (this will be added to the Rules).
- 13. Removes the reinstatement procedure (this will be added to the Rules).
- 14. Adds provision for applicants with a non-Landscape Architecture Accreditation Board (LAAB) accredited degree to sit for the landscape architect exam.
- 15. Adds the Landscape Architect Intern status and requirements.
- 16. Adds the Coordinating Professional requirement on landscape architect design projects.
