The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 816 allows for records of DHHS institutions to be released as allowed by HIPAA and terminates reporting requirements relating to children's behavioral health.

Current Nebraska law is more restrictive than the federal Health Insurance Privacy and Portability Act (HIPAA) regarding the exchange of health information for individuals served in Nebraska's institutions. This bill will align state law with HIPAA requirements, which provide the mechanism for patient privacy but also allow for certain sharing of information.

In addition, this bill terminates reporting requirements relating to children's behavioral health. LB 603, passed in 2009, established the Children's Behavioral Health Helpline (referred to as the Nebraska Family Helpline), Family Navigator Program, and Post Adoption/Post Guardianship Services. It required an annual report to the Legislature. This bill eliminates the annual reporting requirement summarizing the activities of the programs.
