The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB997 revises outdated requirements that various state agencies have offices in the state capitol; restricts Capitol Commission review of proposals to name state buildings or sites or to review proposals by the Department of Administrative Services to use eminent domain to those within the Environs District; provides a process for review and acting on proposals to place or remove monuments from the capitol or its grounds; and provides a process for naming rooms or spaces within the capitol.
