The 27th Amendment was ratified into the United States Constitution on May 7th, 1992. It prohibits any law that increases or decreases the salary of members of Congress from taking effect until the start of the next set of terms of office for Representatives. The 27th Amendment was part of the original set of twelve amendment proposals known as the Bill of Rights. The first ten were ratified. However, the 27th Amendment took 202 years, 7 months, and 12 days to be ratified. Nebraska is one of five states that has not yet ratified the 27th Amendment. LR381 would complete the Nebraska legislature's role in ratification of the 27th Amendment.
