## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 698A**

Approved by the Governor March 30, 2016

Introduced by Mello, 5.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 698, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016; and to declare an emergency. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$103,111 from the Health and Human Services Cash Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$103,111 from the Health and Human Services Cash Fund for FY2017-18 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 698. One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.

Bill 698, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$70,260 for FY2016-17 or \$70,260 for FY2017-18.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$90,390 from the State Settlement Cash Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$92,186 from the State Settlement Cash Fund for FY2017-18 to the Attorney General, for Program 290, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 698, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$65,000 for FY2016-17 or \$66,560 for FY2017-18.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$396,866 from the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$274,470 from the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2017-18 to the Nebraska State Patrol, for Program 100, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 698, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$184,732 for FY2016-17 or \$184,732 for FY2017-18.

Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
