A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend Laws 2015, LB657, section 63; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 938, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016; to change an appropriation; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Laws 2015, LB657, section 63, is amended to read: Sec. 63. AGENCY NO. 14 - PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION Program No. 583 - Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund

 $\underline{\text{Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from}}$ funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$558,604 for FY2016-17 or \$572,568 for FY2017-18.

Sec. 3. Original Laws 2015, LB657, section 63, is repealed. Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
