5 Section 1. Section 79-760.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative6 Supplement, 2016, is amended to read:

79-760.02 In accordance with timelines that are adopted by the State 7 Board of Education, but in no event later than one year following the 8 adoption or modification of state standards, each school district shall 9 adopt measurable quality academic content standards in the subject areas 10 of reading, writing, mathematics, science, and social studies. The 11 standards may be the same as, or may be equal to or exceed in rigor, the 12 measurable academic content standards adopted by the state board and 13 shall cover at least the same grade levels. School districts may work 14 educational 15 collaboratively with service units, with learning communities, or through interlocal agreements to develop such standards. 16

No later than September 1, 2019, for academic content standards in 17 existence on the effective date of this act, and no later than one year 18 19 following the adoption of any new state academic content standards by a school board, such school district shall demonstrate to the State 20 Department of Education that such school district uses evidenced-based 21 curriculum and instructional, assessment, intervention, and parental 22 engagement strategies aligned with the academic content standards that 23 support progress toward grade level proficiency and provide targeted 24 strategies for accelerated learning. 25
