1 1. On page 3, strike lines 21 and 22 and insert the following new 2 subdivision:

"(c) An order granting or denying transfer of the case from county 3 or district court to juvenile court shall be considered a final order for 4 5 the purposes of appeal. Any party may appeal to the Court of Appeals within ten days after an order is entered. Such review shall be advanced 6 7 on the court docket, without an extension of time granted to any party, after which the Court of Appeals shall enter an order as quickly as 8 possible, affirming, reversing, or modifying the order submitted for 9 review. During the pendency of an appeal from an order transferring the 10 case to juvenile court, the juvenile court may enter temporary orders in 11 the best interests of the juvenile.". 12

13 2. On page 6, strike lines 8 and 9 and insert:

"An order granting or denying transfer of the case from juvenile 14 court to county or district court shall be considered a final order for 15 the purposes of appeal. Any party may appeal to the Court of Appeals 16 within ten days after an order is entered. Such review shall be advanced 17 on the court docket, without an extension of time granted to any party, 18 19 after which the Court of Appeals shall enter an order, as quickly as 20 possible, affirming, reversing, or modifying the order submitted for 21 review.".
