Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Sec. 1. increases the minimum wage for people paid by tips. Currently, those individuals are paid cash wages at a minimum rate of \$2.13/hour. LB 211 increases that wage to 40% of the regular minimum wage rate in effect for wages paid between August 1, 2017 and before January 1, 2018, resulting in a \$3.60/hour wage.

For wages paid on or after January 1, 2018, the minimum wage for tipped workers would be 50% of the regular minimum wage rate in effect, resulting in a \$4.50/hour wage.

Sec. 2. requires employers to post a summary of the Wage and Hour Act, including the minimum wage amounts in effect under the Act. The summaries would be provided by the Commissioner of Labor at no cost.

Sec. 3. repealer.

Sec. 4. emergency clause.
