Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 271 proposes the enactment of a new section of law governing the organization and authority for the oversight of the state highway system assigned to the Nebraska Department of Roads and the Director- State Engineer of the Department.

Section 5 of the bill would provide that the Department of Roads may, consistent of federal law through a memorandum of understanding, assume all or part of the responsibility of the United States Department of Transportation (Federal Highway Administration) for determining if federal- aid projects are excluded from federal environmental requirements and for any environmental review, consultation, or action required under federal law.

Consistent with the provisions of federal law, the delegation of authority requires that the state waive sovereign immunity from any lawsuit in federal court for decisions made by the state in reviewing and approving federal environmental documents under the National Environmental Policy Act.
