Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 358 increases the gross income limit for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. In FY 2017-18, the gross income limit is increased to 158% of the Federal Poverty Limit and in FY 2018-19 and beyond to 185% of Federal Poverty Limit but leaves the net income eligibility limit the same.

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 68-1017.02 to update the date to October 1, 2017 for the Department of Health and Human Services to create a TANF-funded program, establishes eligibility for food assistance. In FY 2017-2018, increase the gross income limit to one-hundred and fifty-eight percent of the Federal Poverty Level. In FY 2018-2019 and forward, increase the gross income limit to one-hundred and eighty-five percent of the Federal Poverty Level.

Section 2: Repeals Section 68-1017.02.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 493 strikes the increase to 185% for FY 2018-2019 and beyond for gross income eligibility.
