Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Currently each office, board, commission, and department of state government must provide information to the Legislative Fiscal Office upon request when the information is related to the official duties of the Fiscal Office.

LB530 would delete "upon request," thus requiring each office, board, commission, and department to provide information in its possession to the Fiscal Office when the information is related to the official duties of the Fiscal Office. This information would be required to be furnished electronically.

In addition, LB530 would require the Fiscal Analyst to notify the State Treasurer and the Director of DAS to withhold the appropriation for any office, board, commission, or department which does not furnish the information required above, until such time as the information is provided.
