## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB539 makes the following changes to the Office of Inspector General of the Nebraska Correctional System Act:

\*The Department of Corrections would be required to notify the Inspector General when there has been a death, serious injury, or hospitalization of an employee when the employee was acting in his or her capacity as an employee of the department.

\*The definition of serious injury is amended to mean "an injury which requires urgent and immediate medical treatment and restricts the injured person's usual activity."

\*LB539 would authorize the Inspector General of Corrections to conduct interviews in connection with a relevant ongoing investigation, with the consent of the prosecuting attorney.
