It would add language that requires the court to consider the intent of the party in possession of a weapon (in this case a knife, dagger, dirk or similar instrument) in weighing a charge of carrying a concealed weapon under Nebraska Criminal Code. The added language reads "which in the manner it is used or intended to be used is capable of producing death or serious bodily injury" indicating that prosecutors would need to prove actual or intended use of a weapon to do harm, to classify it as a knife under this section. This has previously been the statutory standard for a classification as a knife under Sec. 28.1202 prior to 2009.
