## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 562 would require the Nebraska Department of Corrections issue a monthly report containing the following statistics: -The number of offenders who have reached or passed their parole eligibility dates, but have not received appropriate rehabilitative and behavioral programming.

-The number and type of all vacant behavioral health staff positions, for each correctional facility and for Corrections as a whole.

-The number of inmates eligible for "community custody" but are not housed in a community-custody facility.

This report shall be submitted electronically to the Legislative Appropriations and Judiciary Committees, the Corrections Inspector General, and the Ombudsman.
