Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 57 would permit, in state court proceedings, unsworn declarations to be executed by witnesses physically located outside the United States in lieu of affidavits, verifications, or other sworn court filings. Knowingly providing false statements provided under this act would be perjury a Class III felony.

Section 1- Provides a penalty of perjury (Class III Felony) for providing false material statements under the act. Provides a penalty of a Class III Felony for subordination of perjury.

Section 2- Provides for a penalty of a Class I misdemeanor for providing false statements under the act in and official proceeding or to mislead a public servant in their duties.

Section 3- Names the Uniform Unsworn Declarations Act.

Section 4- Definition of Terms.

Section 5- The Act applies only to those declarants physically outside the physical boundaries of the United States.

Section 6- Unsworn foreign declarations under this act are given the same legal weight as sworn declarations/ Exceptions.

Section 7- Unsworn foreign declarations used in lieu of sworn declarations must be presented in the same medium as

the legally required sworn declaration.

Section 8- General form of a valid unsworn foreign declaration.

Section 9- Statement of advocacy for promoting legal uniformity.

Section 10- Clarification of application of the Act with relation to Federal statute.
