## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Sec. 1. includes servicemember as a person who would be "preference eligible" when seeking employment with the State of Nebraska or its governmental subdivisions. Servicemember is defined as a person who serves on active duty in the armed forces of the United States, except for training.

The definition of preference eligible is amended to include the spouse of a servicemember, except that preference is limited to the first 180 days of the servicemember's discharge or separation from service.

Sec. 2. states that preference is given to preference eligibles seeking employment with the State of Nebraska or its governmental subdivisions, including initial employment or a return to employment if termination of a previous employment was for other than disciplinary reasons.

AM 280 allows a spouse of a servicemember to be preference eligible while the servicemember is serving on active duty as described in subsection (1) and up to 180 days after the servicemember's discharge or separation from service.
