## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill amends Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 79-1118.01, which lists what qualifies as a disability under Nebraska's Special Education Act (Sec 79-1110-1167), by adding dyslexia as a covered disability.

The bill includes a technical definition of dyslexia.  Explanation of amendments:  This is a technical amendment that on page 3, line 4, after "disability" adds "under subdivision (13) of this section." This ties the technical definition of dyslexia to the list of specific learning disabilities.
