## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 681 adopts the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact.

## SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 38-131 to add the requirement for a physical therapist or a physical therapy assistant to be subject to a criminal background check.

Section 2: Amends Section 38-3208 of the Respiratory Care Practice Act to add clarifying language.

Section 3: Adopts the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact.

Article I: Provides purpose of the Compact.

Article II: Provides for definitions within the Compact.

Article III: Provides requirements for state participation in the Compact.

Article IV: Provides requirements for individuals to participate in the Compact. Article V: Provides requirements for active duty military personnel or their spouses participating in the Compact. Article VI: Provides requirements for adverse actions. Article VII: Provides the establishment of the Compact Commission. Article VIII: Provides requirements for a data system. Article IX: Provides requirements for rulemaking for the Commission. Article X: Provides requirements for oversight, dispute resolution, and enforcement. Article XI: Provides for date of implementation of the Interstate Commission for Physical Therapy Practice and provides requirements for associated rules, withdrawal and amendment requirements of the Compact. Article XII: Provides requirements for construction and severability of the Compact. Section 4: Repeals Sections 38-131 and 38-3208. **Explanation of amendments:** AM 2207 is a white copy amendment and retains the initial Sections 1 through 4. In Article VII, Section g1 strikes immunity for Compact to have liability no greater than a state employee would have under the same or similar circumstances. Merv Riepe, Chairperson
