Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 794 removes the ban on clients from using or consuming alcohol upon the premises of a salon or a nail technology salon. The salon or nail technology salon shall not knowingly permit its employees or clients to use, consume, serve, possess, or distribute controlled substances upon the premises.

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 38-1086 of the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology, and Body Art Practice Act to remove the ban on clients from using or consuming alcohol upon the premises of a salon. The salon shall not allow employees or clients to use, consume, serve, possess or distribute controlled substances upon the premises.

Section 2: Amends Section 38-10,142 of the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology, and Body Art Practice Act to remove the ban on clients from using or consuming alcohol upon the premises of a nail technology salon. The nail technology salon shall not allow employees or clients to use, consume, serve, possess or distribute controlled substances upon the premises.

Explanation of amendments:

LB 794, as amended by AM 2000, removes the ban on clients from using or consuming alcohol upon the premises of a salon or a nail technology salon.

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 38-1086 of the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology, and Body Art Practice Act to remove the ban on clients from using or consuming alcohol upon the premises of a salon.

Section 2: Amends Section 38-10,142 of the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology, and Body Art Practice Act to remove the ban on clients from using or consuming alcohol upon the premises of a nail technology salon.
