Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would exclude from the definition of "marijuana" any material, preparation, mixture, compound, or other substance which contains ten percent or less cannabidiol by weight and three-tenths of one percent or less tetrahydrocannabinols by weight.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1834 deletes language from LB 832 which would require chemical testing described in hearing testimony as beyond the current technical capacity of lab technicians. As amended by AM 1834, LB 832 would remove cannabidiol from the definition of the schedule I drug "marijuana." Previous exceptions created by the legislature for UNMC research and for FDA approved drugs would be preserved.
