Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 840 requires the Foster Care Review Office to submit a report electronically on "March 1," "June 1," "September 1" and "December 1." The "September 1" report is designated as the Foster Care Review Office's annual report. The executive director of the Foster Care Review Office shall provide additional reports, at the request of the Health and Human Services Committee, if additional issues, policy concerns or problems come to the attention of the Foster Care Review Office.

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 43-1303 to restructure and clarify the reporting requirements of the Foster Care Review Office. Changes annual report to "September 1." Provide "March 1," "June 1," "September 1," and "December 1" as dates for report submissions.

Section 2: Repeals Section 43-1303.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1596 adds the term "juvenile justice" to the Foster Care Review Office reporting requirements.
