## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 865 would prohibit municipalities from suspending the requirement that ordinances be read on three different days for any ordinance for the redrawing of district boundaries.

LB 865 would also prohibit cities of the metropolitan class and cities of the primary class from suspending the requirement that ordinances be read on three different days for any ordinance for the annexation of territory.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM 1549 clarifies that provisions of the bill dealing with the redrawing of district boundaries only apply to city council or village board of trustees election districts or wards.

AM 1549 also clarifies that Sections 1 through 3 of the bill apply to cities of the metropolitan class, cities of the primary class, and cities of the first class, respectively.
