Legislative Bill 885 would require the county clerk to send a copy of the protest form (Form 422), attachments, and the county board of equalization's decision to the property owner. The bill would take effect on January 1, 2019. **Explanation of amendments:** The amendment adds language to accommodate persons authorized to protest a property tax assessment on behalf of the owner and to require such person to provide the authorization as part of the protest.
