Not later than July 1, 2019, the State Fire Code would be required to conform generally to the standards recommended by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Pamphlet Number 1 (known as the "Fire Code"), 2012 edition, the NFPA Pamphlet Number 101 (known as the "Life Safety Code"), 2012 edition, and associated pamphlets. Currently, the State Fire Code conforms generally to the 2000 edition of the Life Safety Code. LB 889 would also outright repeal the high-rise building fire code, which is obsolete.
