Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 902 would allow any government entity to withhold information regarding firearm registration, possession, sale, or use that is obtained by the entity for purposes of an application permitted or required by law or contained in a permit or license issued by the entity from the public.

The bill requires an entity withholding information pursuant to this provision make the information available to any federal, state, county, or local law enforcement agency upon request.
