Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1012 allows operators of self-service storage facilities to apply for a license to sell insurance which covers the loss or damage to personal property contained in a storage space or in transit during a rental agreement period. The applicant for a license shall pay an initial and renewal annual application fee of up to \$100 as determined by the Department of Insurance (DOI). DOI is authorized to revoke or suspend licenses and impose penalties for violations. An administrative fine of up to \$1,000 may be imposed per violation. Licensees are exempt from continuing education, prelicensing education and examination requirements. The bill is operative on October 1, 2018.

<u>Revenues</u>: The DOI indicates the Self-Storage Association estimates there are about 400 self-storage facilities currently in the state. The department projects about 50% of the operators of self-storage facilities will apply for a license pursuant to the bill. The license fee currently being charged by DOI is \$50, so there will be an increase in annual cash fund revenue of about \$10,000.

It is unknown if there will be any violations of the requirements of the bill by licensees. If so, an administrative fine may be imposed by the DOI. Any revenue received from an administrative fine will be deposited in the Permanent School Fund, the interest from which accrues to the public schools.

<u>Expenditures</u>: There will be a workload increase for the DOI to issue licenses and regulate the issuance of insurance by self-storage facility operators. The agency indicates that existing staff and resources will be able to handle the increased workload.
