1 Section 1. Section 71-468, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 3 71-468 In order to prevent, detect, and control pneumonia and
- 4 influenza outbreaks in Nebraska:
- 5 (1) Each - each general acute hospital, and intermediate care
- facility, nursing facility, and skilled nursing facility shall annually, 6
- beginning no later than October 1 and ending on the following April 1, 7
- offer onsite vaccinations for influenza and pneumococcal disease to all 8
- 9 residents and to all inpatients prior to discharge, pursuant to
- procedures of the facility and in accordance with the recommendations of 10
- the advisory committee on immunization practices of the Centers for 11
- Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Public Health Service 12
- 13 of the United States Department of Health and Human Services as the
- recommendations existed on January 1, 2017; and 2012. 14
- (2) Each nursing facility and skilled nursing facility shall 15
- annually, beginning no later than October 1 and ending on the following 16
- April 1, offer onsite vaccinations for (a) influenza and pneumococcal 17
- disease to all residents and (b) influenza to all employees, pursuant to 18
- 19 procedures of the facility and in accordance with the recommendations of
- the advisory committee on immunization practices of the Centers for 20
- Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Public Health Service 21
- of the United States Department of Health and Human Services as the 22
- 23 recommendations existed on January 1, 2017. This section shall not apply
- 24 in individual cases when contraindicated or if a national shortage of the
- 25 vaccine exists. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require any
- facility listed in this section to cover the cost of a vaccination 26
