- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Game Law; to amend section 37-613,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change amounts of certain
- 3 liquidated damages; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 37-613, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 37-613 (1) Any person who sells, purchases, takes, or possesses
- 4 contrary to the Game Law any wildlife shall be liable to the State of
- 5 Nebraska for the damages caused thereby. Such damages shall be:
- 6 (a) Twenty-five Fifteen thousand dollars for each mountain sheep;
- 7 (b) <u>Ten</u> Five thousand dollars for each elk with a minimum of twelve
- 8 total points and <u>three</u> one thousand five hundred dollars for any other
- 9 elk;
- 10 (c) Ten Five thousand dollars for each whitetail deer with a minimum
- 11 of eight total points and an inside spread between beams of at least
- 12 <u>sixteen</u> eighteen inches, <u>two</u> one thousand dollars for any other antlered
- 13 whitetail deer, and <u>five hundred</u> two hundred fifty dollars for each
- 14 antlerless whitetail deer and whitetail doe deer;
- 15 (d) Five thousand dollars for each mule deer with a minimum of eight
- 16 total points and an inside spread between beams of at least twenty-two
- 17 twenty-four inches and two one thousand dollars for any other mule deer;
- 18 (e) Five thousand dollars for each antelope with the shortest horn
- 19 measuring a minimum of fourteen inches in length and one thousand dollars
- 20 for any other antelope;
- 21 (f) One thousand five hundred dollars for each bear or moose or each
- 22 individual animal of any threatened or endangered species of wildlife not
- 23 otherwise listed in this subsection;
- 24 (g) Five thousand hundred dollars for each mountain lion, lynx,
- 25 bobcat, river otter, or raw pelt thereof;
- 26 (h) Twenty-five dollars for each raccoon, opossum, skunk, or raw
- 27 pelt thereof;
- 28 (i) Five thousand dollars for each eagle;
- 29 (j) Five One hundred dollars for each wild turkey;
- 30 (k) Twenty-five dollars for each dove;
- 31 (1) Seventy-five dollars for each other game bird, other game

- 1 animal, other fur-bearing animal, raw pelt thereof, or nongame wildlife
- 2 in need of conservation as designated by the commission pursuant to
- 3 section 37-805, not otherwise listed in this subsection;
- 4 (m) Fifty dollars for each wild bird not otherwise listed in this
- 5 subsection;
- 6 (n) Seven hundred fifty dollars for each swan or paddlefish;
- 7 (o) Two hundred dollars for each master angler fish measuring more
- 8 than twelve inches in length;
- 9 (p) Fifty dollars for each game fish measuring more than twelve
- 10 inches in length not otherwise listed in this subsection;
- 11 (q) Twenty-five dollars for each other game fish; and
- 12 (r) Fifty dollars for any other species of game not otherwise listed
- 13 in this subsection.
- 14 (2) The commission shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 15 to provide for a list of master angler fish which are subject to this
- 16 section and to prescribe guidelines for measurements and point
- 17 determinations as required by this section. The commission may adopt a
- 18 scoring system which is uniformly recognized for this purpose.
- 19 (3) Such damages may be collected by the commission by civil action.
- 20 In every case of conviction for any of such offenses, the court or
- 21 magistrate before whom such conviction is obtained shall further enter
- 22 judgment in favor of the State of Nebraska and against the defendant for
- 23 liquidated damages in the amount set forth in this section and collect
- 24 such damages by execution or otherwise. Failure to obtain conviction on a
- 25 criminal charge shall not bar a separate civil action for such liquidated
- 26 damages. Damages collected pursuant to this section shall be remitted to
- 27 the secretary of the commission who shall remit them to the State
- 28 Treasurer for credit to the State Game Fund.
