1	Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate (1)
2	<u>\$271,320 from the General Fund for FY2017-18 and (2) \$271,320 from the</u>
3	<u>General Fund for FY2018-19 to the University of Nebraska to provide funds</u>
4	for one-year postgraduate psychiatric and behavioral health medicine
5	fellowships for physician assistants to prepare the participants to
6	provide advanced psychiatric and behavioral health care. The University
7	<u>of Nebraska shall use the funds to develop and offer coursework and</u>
8	clinical rotations for participating fellows and to provide stipends,
9	clinical supervision, coordination, and other services for such fellows
10	to help the State of Nebraska expeditiously recruit, retain, and increase
11	the competence of the psychiatric prescriber workforce.
