- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to jury
- 3 sequestration; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 29-2022, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

2 amended to read:

3 The court may order a jury sequestered during trial or 29-2022 after a case is finally submitted to the jury on the court's own motion 4 5 or on motion by a party for good cause shown. When a case is finally 6 submitted to the jury, they must be kept together in some convenient 7 place, under the charge of an officer, until they agree upon a verdict or 8 are discharged by the court. The officer having them in charge shall not 9 suffer any communication to be made to them, or make any himself, except 10 to ask them whether they have agreed upon a verdict, unless by order of 11 the court; nor shall he communicate to anyone, before the verdict is delivered, any matter in relation to the state of their deliberations. If 12 13 the jury <u>separates</u> are <u>permitted to separate during the trial</u>, the jurors 14 they shall be admonished by the court that it is their duty not to converse communicate with or suffer themselves to be addressed by any 15 16 other person on the subject of the trial, nor to listen to any conversation on the subject, nor read, listen to, or view any reports of 17 the case in the media, \div and that it is their duty not to form or express 18 19 an opinion thereon until the cause is finally submitted to them.
