- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to political subdivisions; to prohibit cities
- 2 and counties from canceling health insurance coverage for injured
- 3 law enforcement officers as prescribed.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) No city or county offering an individual or family
- 2 <u>health insurance policy to law enforcement officers shall cancel such</u>
- 3 <u>individual or family health insurance for any law enforcement officer who</u>
- 4 suffers serious bodily injury from an assault that occurs while the
- 5 officer is on duty and that results in the officer falling below the
- 6 minimum number of working hours needed to maintain his or her regular
- 7 individual or family health insurance.
- 8 (2) The city or county shall only be obligated to provide such
- 9 <u>health insurance while the law enforcement officer is employed with the</u>
- 10 <u>city or county.</u>
- 11 (3) A city or county may cancel such health insurance if the law
- 12 <u>enforcement officer does not return to employment within twelve months</u>
- 13 <u>after the date of injury.</u>
