- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>(1) For purposes of this section, employer means any</u>
2	individual, partnership, limited liability company, association, joint-
3	stock company, trust, or corporation employing six or more individuals in
4	<u>this state as employees.</u>
5	<u>(2) No employer shall require any employee to work without a rest</u>
6	period of at least fifteen minutes during each four hours worked. Such
7	rest period shall be in addition to the regularly scheduled lunch period
8	for such employee. No reduction in the compensation of the employee shall
9	<u>be made for such rest period.</u>
10	(3) Nothing in this section prohibits employers and employees from
11	establishing rest periods different from those provided in this section
12	pursuant to a collective-bargaining agreement.
13	(4) Any employer violating this section shall be guilty of a Class
