LEGISLATIVE BILL 515

Committee: Business and Labor

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to education; to amend sections 85-1539 and 85-1540, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to create the Nebraska Integrated Education and Training Grant Program; to state findings; to define terms; to authorize grants; to require policy recommendations; to require reporting; to state intent to provide an appropriation; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds that in order to be competitive in
- 2 <u>a global economy, Nebraska must develop educational programs in high-</u>
- 3 demand fields. The Legislature further finds that business interests in
- 4 Nebraska have identified development of a skilled workforce as essential
- 5 <u>to building Nebraska's economy. Additionally, the federal Workforce</u>
- 6 Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014, 29 U.S.C. 3101, as such act
- 7 existed on January 1, 2017, included the first requirement for states to
- 8 provide integrated education and training services. Finally, community
- 9 colleges in Nebraska are positioned to establish innovative approaches to
- 10 <u>developing credentials with meaning in the workforce that meet</u>
- 11 <u>educational demand.</u>
- Sec. 2. <u>For purposes of sections 1 to 5 of this act:</u>
- 13 (1) Adult education means academic instruction and education
- 14 services below the postsecondary level for any person who is sixteen
- 15 years of age or older, who is not enrolled in high school and is not
- 16 required to be enrolled in school, that increase the ability to read,
- 17 write, and speak in English and perform mathematics or other activities
- 18 necessary for the attainment of a high school diploma or a diploma of
- 19 high school equivalency, for the transition to postsecondary education
- 20 <u>and training, and to obtain employment;</u>
- 21 (2) Commission means the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary
- 22 Education;
- 23 (3) Committee means the Nebraska Community College Student
- 24 Performance and Occupational Education Grant Committee;
- 25 (4) Integrated education and training means instruction that
- 26 provides adult education and literacy activities or remedial education
- 27 <u>concurrently and contextually with workforce preparation activities and</u>
- 28 workforce training for a specific occupation or occupational cluster for
- 29 the purpose of educational and career advancement; and
- 30 (5) Remedial education means instruction and support to prepare a
- 31 student who is assessed by the postsecondary educational institution that

- 1 the student has chosen as being academically underprepared to
- 2 <u>successfully complete a program of study at such postsecondary</u>
- 3 educational institution.
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) The Nebraska Integrated Education and Training Grant
- 5 Program is established. The grant program shall provide grants to
- 6 community colleges for the purpose of developing and implementing local
- 7 programs of integrated education and training. The committee shall
- 8 <u>administer the program and shall develop grant applications, procedures,</u>
- 9 and guidelines as needed.
- 10 (2) The committee shall allocate grants of up to three years to
- 11 community colleges through a competitive process. To be eligible, a
- 12 <u>community college shall submit an application to the committee</u>
- 13 <u>describing:</u>
- 14 <u>(a) The specific integrated education and training instructional</u>
- 15 model to be implemented by the local program of integrated education and
- 16 training;
- 17 <u>(b) How the local program of integrated education and training will</u>
- 18 be designed and implemented by educators with expertise in adult
- 19 <u>education and occupational skills training;</u>
- 20 <u>(c) How the local program of integrated education and training will</u>
- 21 prepare students to receive a high school diploma or diploma of high
- 22 school equivalency if necessary;
- 23 <u>(d) How the local program of integrated education and training will</u>
- 24 prepare students to obtain postsecondary credentials;
- 25 (e) If applicable, how the local program of integrated education and
- 26 training will offer industry-recognized credentials;
- 27 (f) The occupations or industry for which the local program of
- 28 integrated education and training will prepare students for employment
- 29 and how the program will fit into a career pathway;
- 30 <u>(g) Evidence of employer demand for completers of the local program</u>
- 31 of integrated education and training;

- 1 (h) How the local program of integrated education and training will
- 2 provide student support services, including guidance counseling, to
- 3 assist with student success;
- 4 (i) Strategies for tracking and reporting outcomes and evaluation
- 5 reporting for the local program of integrated education and training;
- 6 (j) Evidence of matching funds from local or philanthropic sources
- 7 of at least one quarter of the total projected cost for the local program
- 8 of integrated education and training;
- 9 (k) Description of target population, such as unemployed,
- 10 underemployed, low-income, youth, dislocated workers, other, or a
- 11 <u>combination of target populations and how the local program of integrated</u>
- 12 <u>education and training will serve such target population; and</u>
- 13 (1) Other information as required by the committee.
- 14 Sec. 4. The commission shall develop an annual evaluation of the
- 15 Nebraska Integrated Education and Training Grant Program that includes
- 16 the following:
- 17 <u>(1) The local programs of integrated education and training that</u>
- 18 each community college offers by name;
- 19 (2) The number of students who enrolled in each local program of
- 20 integrated education and training;
- 21 (3) The number of students who successfully complete each local
- 22 program of integrated education and training; and
- 23 (4) The percentage of students who obtained employment in the
- 24 occupation or industry indicated in the grant application or who enrolled
- 25 for additional education related to such occupation or industry within
- 26 <u>six months after successful completion for each local program of</u>
- 27 <u>integrated education and training.</u>
- Sec. 5. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate funds to
- 29 carry out the Nebraska Integrated Education and Training Grant Program
- 30 from the General Fund. Up to fifteen percent of such funds may be
- 31 retained by the commission for administering grants, providing technical

1 assistance, and conducting the annual evaluation required pursuant to

- 2 <u>section 4 of this act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 6. Section 85-1539, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 4 amended to read:
- 5 85-1539 (1) There is hereby created the Nebraska Community College
- 6 Student Performance and Occupational Education Grant Committee. The
- 7 committee shall consist of (a) a representative of the Coordinating
- 8 Commission for Postsecondary Education who shall serve as chairperson of
- 9 the committee, (b) a representative of the Department of Economic
- 10 Development, (c) a representative of the Department of Labor, (d) a
- 11 representative of the State Department of Education, (e) a representative
- 12 affiliated with one of the two community college areas with the two
- 13 smallest full-time equivalent student enrollment totals for the most
- 14 recent fiscal year, (f) a representative affiliated with one of the two
- 15 community college areas with the two largest full-time equivalent student
- 16 enrollment totals for the most recent fiscal year, and (g) a
- 17 representative affiliated with one of the two community college areas not
- 18 included in the categories provided in subdivisions (1)(e) and (f) of
- 19 this section. Each member shall be appointed by the agency or community
- 20 college areas being represented. The representatives appointed pursuant
- 21 to subdivisions (1)(e) through (g) of this section shall serve terms of
- 22 two years and shall be succeeded by a representative affiliated with the
- 23 community college areas not represented for the preceding term. The
- 24 committee shall administer the grant program provided by subsection (2)
- 25 of this section and the Nebraska Integrated Education and Training Grant
- 26 Program pursuant to sections 1 to 5 of this act.
- 27 (2) The committee shall develop quidelines for and annually
- 28 determine the allocation of aid or grants to the community colleges for
- 29 (a) applied technology and occupational faculty training, instructional
- 30 equipment upgrades, employee assessment, preemployment training,
- 31 employment training, and dislocated worker programs benefiting the State

- 1 of Nebraska or (b) programs or activities to enhance (i) student
- 2 performance in the areas of degree, certificate, or diploma completion,
- 3 retention, or foundations education as defined in section 85-932.01 or
- 4 (ii) the collection, reporting, analysis, and utilization of student
- 5 data. The total amount allocated for a fiscal year shall not exceed the
- 6 amounts appropriated from the Nebraska Community College Student
- 7 Performance and Occupational Education Grant Fund and such other funds as
- 8 may be appropriated by the Legislature for purposes of this section for
- 9 such fiscal year. The commission shall certify the allocation determined
- 10 by the committee on or before September 10 of the fiscal year for which
- 11 such allocation is being certified and shall report such allocation to
- 12 the Department of Administrative Services. The commission shall
- 13 distribute the allocated funds to the selected community college board or
- 14 boards in a single payment between the fifth and twentieth day of October
- 15 of each year.
- 16 (3) Applications for aid or grants pursuant to <u>subsection (2) of</u>
- 17 this section may be submitted by a community college area independently
- or in collaboration with other community college areas.
- 19 Sec. 7. Section 85-1540, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 85-1540 There is hereby created the Nebraska Community College
- 22 Student Performance and Occupational Education Grant Fund. The fund shall
- 23 be under the direction of the Nebraska Community College Student
- 24 Performance and Occupational Education Grant Committee and shall be
- 25 administered by the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education.
- 26 The fund shall consist of money received by the state in the form of
- 27 grants or gifts from nonfederal sources, such other amounts as may be
- 28 transferred or otherwise accrue to the fund, and any investment income
- 29 earned on the fund. The fund shall be used to provide aid or grants to
- 30 the community colleges pursuant to <u>subsections (2) and (3) of section</u>
- 31 85-1539. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested

1 by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital

- 4 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
