**LEGISLATIVE BILL 530**

Introduced by Harr, 8.

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Legislature; to amend section 50-420,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change requirements related
- 3 to information provided to the Legislative Fiscal Analyst; to
- 4 provide for withholding appropriations for noncompliance; to repeal
- 5 the original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 50-420, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is  
2 amended to read:

3 50-420 (1) Each officer, board, commission, and department of state  
4 government, including the Accounting Administrator of the Department of  
5 Administrative Services, shall furnish electronically to the Legislative  
6 Fiscal Analyst, ~~upon request,~~ any information in its possession,  
7 including records received from other officers, boards, commissions, or  
8 departments of state government, ~~whether such information is retained in~~  
9 ~~computer files or otherwise,~~ if such information is directly related to  
10 the performance of the official duties of the Legislative Fiscal Analyst  
11 under sections 50-418 to 50-420.

12 (2) Beginning July 1, 2017, the Legislative Fiscal Analyst shall  
13 notify the State Treasurer and the Director of Administrative Services to  
14 withhold the appropriations for any officer, board, commission, or  
15 department of state government which does not furnish the information  
16 required by subsection (1) of this section until such information is  
17 furnished as required. The State Treasurer and the director shall  
18 withhold appropriations beginning five days after receipt of notification  
19 from the Legislative Fiscal Analyst.

20 Sec. 2. Original section 50-420, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
21 Nebraska, is repealed.

22 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when  
23 passed and approved according to law.
