- of certain information relating to performing a lethal injection;

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 84-712.08, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 84-712.08 (1) If it is determined by any federal department or
- 4 agency or other federal source of funds, services, or essential
- 5 information, that any provision of sections 84-712, 84-712.01, 84-712.03
- 6 to 84-712.09, and 84-1413 would cause the denial of any funds, services,
- 7 or essential information from the United States Government which would
- 8 otherwise definitely be available to an agency of this state, such
- 9 provision shall be suspended as to such agency, but only to the extent
- 10 necessary to prevent denial of such funds, services, or essential
- 11 information.
- 12 (2) Records containing any information reasonably calculated to lead
- 13 to the identity of any person or entity that manufactures, supplies,
- 14 compounds, or prescribes the substance or substances, medical supplies,
- 15 or medical equipment utilized to perform a lethal injection shall be
- 16 <u>confidential</u> and exempt from disclosure pursuant to sections 84-712 to
- 17 84-712.09 and shall not be disclosed.
- 18 Sec. 2. Original section 84-712.08, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 19 Nebraska, is repealed.
